

RESOLUTION NO. 2670

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN SAID CITY OF MAYWOOD ON THE 5TH DAY OF MARCH, 1974, DECLARING THE RESULT THEREOF AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS ARE PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a regular general municipal election was held and conducted in the City of Maywood, County of Los Angeles, State of California, on Tuesday, the 5th day of March, 1974, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes cast thereat, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2666 adopted the 13th day of February, 1974, the City Clerk of the City of Maywood canvassed the returns of said election and has certified the results to this City Council, said results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That there were thirteen (13) voting precincts established for the purpose of holding said election consisting of the regular election precincts in the City of Maywood as established for the holding of state and county elections.

SECTION 2: That said regular general municipal election was held for the purpose of electing the following officers of said City as required by the laws relating to cities in the State of California, to wit:

Two (2) Members of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years;

A City Clerk of said City for the full term of four years;

A City Treasurer of said City for the full term of four years.

SECTION 3: That at said regular general municipal election, the following measure was submitted to the electors of said City, to wit:

"Shall the City Council of the City of Maywood enter into a Contract with the Public Employees' Retirement System to provide a "2% at 55, with 1959 survivors benefits" retirement for Safety (Police) employees and a "Modified 1/50th Formula" retirement for Miscellaneous Employees; continue existing Social Security system for two years only; and levy the required additional ad valorem (property) tax (initial annual cost estimated to be \$86,557) necessary to fund said retirement program, which tax rate is estimated to be 50¢ per \$100.00 of assessed valuation? "

SECTION 4: That the whole number of votes cast in said City (except absent voter ballots) was 2,147.

That the whole number of absent voter ballots cast in said City was 33, making a total of 2,180 votes cast in said City.

SECTION 5: That the names of persons voted for at said election for Member of the City Council of said City are as follows:

That the measure voted upon at said election is as follows:

"Shall the City Council of the City of Maywood enter into a Contract with the Public Employees' Retirement System to provide a "2% at 55, with 1959 survivor benefits" retirement for Safety (Police) employees and a "Modified 1/50th Formula" retirement for Miscellaneous Employees; continue existing Social Security system for two years only; and levy the required additional ad valorem (property) tax (initial annual cost estimated to be \$86,557) necessary to fund said retirement program, which tax rate is estimated to be 50¢ per \$100.00 of assessed valuation?"

That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of such persons above named for the respective officers for which said persons were candidates and for and against the measure were as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

that: SECTION 6: The City Council does declare and determine

JOHN CUNNINGHAM was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years;

WILLIAM A. HAMILTON was elected as Member of the City Council of said City for the full term of four years;

LEONARD R. LOCHER was elected City Clerk of said City for the full term of four years;

RUTH S. HOGREFE was elected City Treasurer of said City for the full term of four years.

That as a result of said election, a majority of the qualified voters voting on said measure relating to adoption of a retirement system for employees did vote in favor thereof, and that said proposition was carried, and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 7: The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of said City, a statement of the result of said election, showing:

- (1) The whole number of votes cast in the city;
- (2) The names of the persons voted for;
- (3) The measures voted upon;
- (4) For what office each person was voted for;
- (5) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person, and for and against each measure;
- (6) The number of votes given in the city to each person, and for and against each measure.

SECTION 8: That the City Clerk shall immediately make and, upon compliance by the persons elected with the provisions of Section 11550 and Section 11559 of the Elections Code of the State of California, shall deliver to each of such persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by him and duly authenticated; that he shall also administer to each person elected, the Oath of Office prescribed in the State Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe thereto and file the same in his office. Whereupon, each and all of said persons so elected shall be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 9: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.
